Relocating Wildlife Requires Caution Relocation, sometimes referred to as translocation or transplantation, is the capture and transfer of a wild animal from one area to another Relocation has been used to enhance or reintroduce populations of rare or locally extinct wildlife, provide hunting or wildlife viewing opportunities, and
