I Know Why the Caged Bird Sings The title of the book comes from the poem Sympathy, by Paul Laurence Dunbar (1872-1924) He was the son of escaped slaves and wrote about a bird in a cage which has beaten the bars until its wings are bruised Its song is not a song of joy, but a prayer for freedom

Caged Bird and Gather Together Angelou uses the metaphor of a bird struggling to escape its cage described in the Paul Laurence Dunbar poem "Sympathy" throughout all of her autobiographies; she uses the metaphor in the titles of both I Know Why the Caged Bird Sings and her sixth autobiography A Song Flung Up to Heaven[19]
